- ✓ Watercolor Palette with lid (rectangular with mixing area)
- ✓ Tube Watercolors your usual colors you have but if you do not have any may I suggest these colors. (cadmium Red, cadmium yellow light, cadmium orange, ultra marine blue, cobalt blue, sap green or hookers green, alizarin Crimson, cerulean blue) Good brands of paint are Cheap Joe's, Winsor Newton, Grumbacher Academy, M. Graham, Van Gough, Holbein, Daniel Smith. Please do not get cheap watercolors like cottman or pelican. Bring the watercolors you normally use.
- ✓ Watercolor Brushes (Soft, prefer round size 8, 12) I use the silver black velvet brand. Larger ones if you prefer to paint large.
- ✓ Watercolor Paper Arches 140 pound 1-2 Sheets Cold press (I will bring some for sale)
- ✓ Paper towels and cheap tissue
- ✓ Water containers (2) Large butter dish size, #2 pencil
- ✓ Sketch pad and/or notebook
- \checkmark White eraser or kneaded eraser
- ✓ Technical pencil
- ✓ Tracing paper
- ✓ Digital Camera, ipad, tablet, phone
- ✓ Crystal like vases, glass, shiny objects like silver, pots, copper pots etc.
- ✓ We will set up a still life variety and do some photographing and I will instruct on this so don't forget a digital camera. Does not have to be anything fancy. We will send to Walmart to be processed at least two photos.
- ✓ I will bring some fabric for draping and a back drop
- ✓ I will bring the computer and printer and instruct you on using electronics to get your composition
- ✓ We probably will not work larger than $\frac{1}{2}$ sheet of watercolor paper
