Workshop Overview

Linda’s workshop will illustrate the many dimensions of this exciting, rich-hued, yet very portable medium. Students will learn layering, blending, color mixing, line impression, burnishing and lifting. This class promises fresh possibilities for everyone whether they are a beginner or an experienced colored pencil artist. Students will learn the “tricks of the trade” Linda has mastered through decades of colored pencil painting.

For this particularly fun, casual but information-packed class, a packet will be provided. The packet will include paper with a printed template so no drawing is required, a 5” x 7” reference photo, a worksheet, a palette guide, helpful hints and instructions.

Class times will be from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily, with an hour for lunch. A microwave and refrigerator are provided for those who prefer to bring their lunch.
